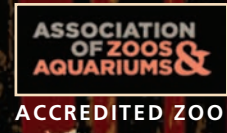

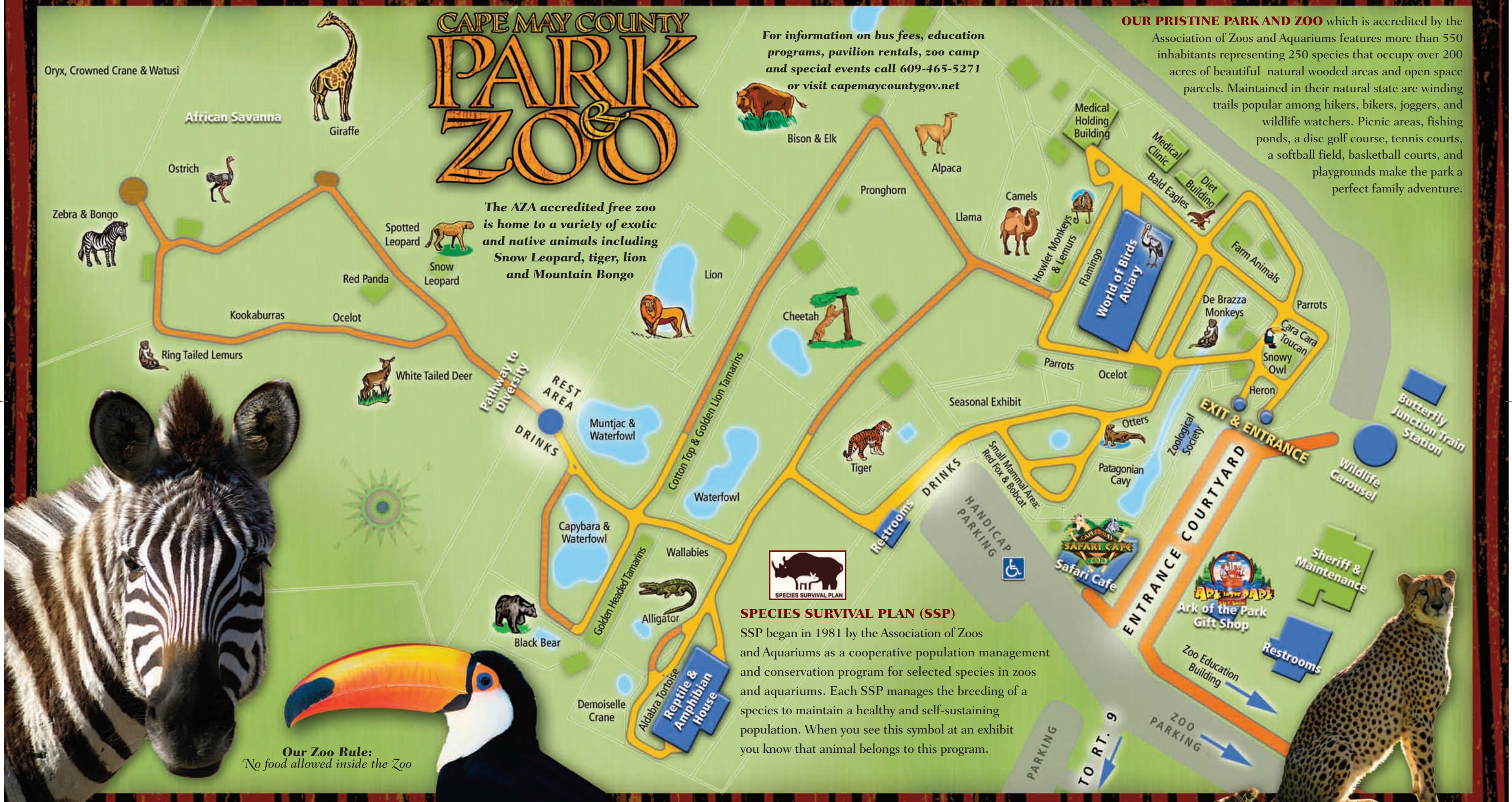

**OUR PRISTINE PARK AND ZOO** which is accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums features more than 550 inhabitants representing 250 species that occupy over 200 acres of beautiful natural wooded areas and open space parcels. Maintained in their natural state are winding trails popular among hikers, bikers, joggers, and wildlife watchers. **SPECIES SURVIVAL PLAN (SSP)**  
SSP began in 1981 by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums as a cooperative population management and conservation program for selected species in zoos and aquariums. Each SSP manages the breeding of a species to maintain a healthy and self-sustaining population. When you see this symbol at an exhibit you know that animal belongs to this program.
